The main pool has a zero depth area, diving well and is a 6 lane 25 meter competitive lap pool. We also offer a zero depth wading pool for our little swimmers with the famous “Magic Mushroom”, which will shower you with some of the cleanest water in the area. Some of our special programs are 2 sessions of swim lessons, a senior swim, ladies day and “The Dawg Daze of Summer”.
